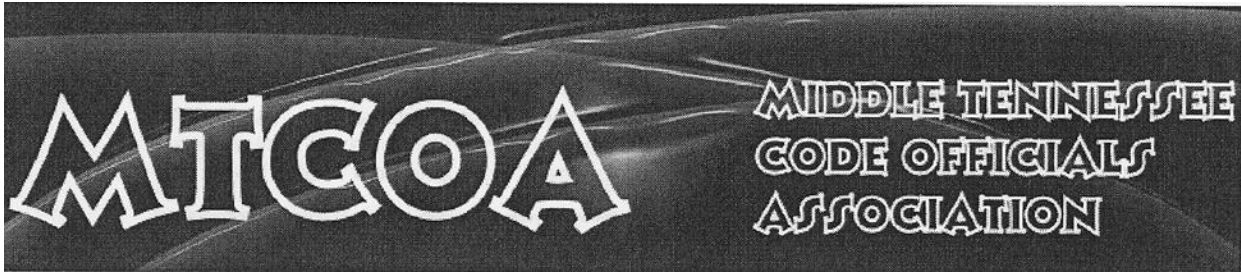
**Board Reports:**
