



MTCOA MEETING MINUTES
WILLIAMSON COUNTY AG EXPO CENTER – FRANKLIN, TN
MARCH 15, 2012

First Vice President Ray Hubner called the meeting to order at 11:00 AM. All members stood as Immediate Past President Terry Franklin led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance. Self introductions were then conducted by all 51 members and guests in attendance.

Thanks to Elizabeth Goodwin, Architectural Representative with Pella Windows, for teaching the class on Window Performance and Replacement Requirements for Commercial Buildings. A special thank you was also extended to the Williamson County Ag Expo Center for allowing MTCOA use of their facility for this month's class.

Treasurer Michael Rinehart stated that as of February 29, 2012 account balances were as follows: Checking Account (\$3,537.85); Savings Account (\$2,009.48).
