



MTCOA MEETING MINUTES
MT. JULIET COMMUNITY CENTER
MAY 19, 2011

President Terry Franklin called the meeting to order at 12:05 PM. All members stood as Carl Martin led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Thanks to Barry Westbrook for teaching the class on Meeting the New Energy Star Standards. Special thanks was extended to the City of Mt Juliet for hosting the class and for DocAir providing lunch to the membership.

Treasurer Mike Bauer stated that as of April 30, 2011 account balances were as follows: Checking Account (\$2,073.01); Savings Account (\$2,008.69). Steve Mills made a motion with a second from Dwayne Hicks approving the treasurer's report. Motion carried by unanimous vote of all members present.

Minutes from the April 2011 Meeting were available for members to pick up from the table as they signed the class roster at the beginning of class. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Dwayne Hicks, seconded by Second Vice President Ray Hubner. Motion carried by unanimous vote of all members present.

Dwayne Hicks informed members that he would be teaching a free test prep class on the 2009 International Mechanical Code, Wednesday, June 1st beginning at 8:00 AM. The morning session will cover residential mechanical and the afternoon will cover commercial mechanical. The class will be held in this same room (Mt Juliet Community Center – Panattoni Room) and is open to the first 50 people who register by email. Class information will be posted on MTCOA's website as it becomes available.

Steve Mills informed members that state legislation recently passed an amendment to "Katie Beth's Law" regarding the new pool alarm requirements that went into effect January 1, 2011.

The new amendment basically will allow the electrical inspector to accept a receipt as proof of the required pool alarm without actually seeing it installed. The amended bill was still waiting for signature by the Governor. A copy of the new bill will be posted on the website as soon as it becomes available and/or passed into law.

The June class is scheduled to be held in Thompson's Station with a presentation by Smart Vent. The class has been approved for 1 hour of continuing education and the Board was still seeking another speaker to obtain a second hour at class time. Members were encouraged to check the website for class information and registration as it becomes available.

There being no further business Dwayne Hicks made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Second Vice President Ray Hubner. Motion carried.
